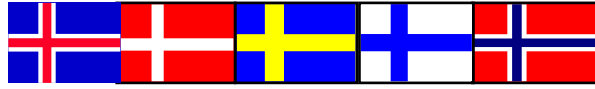
- 1. Name:** **Nordic Birdstrike Advisory Group (NBSAG)**

- 2. Objectives:** The objective of the advisory group is to give advice on how to minimize the risk of the collision between aircraft and birds or animals. This should be obtained by:
 - a. Co-ordination of efforts/ambitions among the Nordic countries.
 - b. Collection of data on bird congregations and movements within the Nordic countries and bird hazards on and around airports and analyses of data.
 - c. Exchange of experiences between the Nordic organizations and
 - d. Propagation of information regarding bird strikes and relevant subjects by means of for example:
 - i. Website
 - ii. Direct contact

- 3. Organization** Attendees to the meetings are automatic members of the group, the following organizations may participate at the meetings:
 - a. Nordic CAA
 - b. Nordic airlines
 - c. Nordic airports
 - d. Nordic air forces
 - e. Nordic environmental institutes

Each member is responsible for follow-up actions as described in meeting minutes. Each country is responsibility for planning and arranging meetings according to the arrangement list. The group meets every second year. Minutes shall be taken at each meeting and distributed to all invited members.
